## ***Kemberton News***

### Parish Council

Shropshire Council has announced that from October all residents will have to pay £56 per annum if they require their green waste to be collected fortnightly. Residents. need to go to Shropshire Councils website

Where it states

"From 1 October 2024 you'll need to subscribe to our garden waste collection service if you'd like us to continue collecting your garden bin.

The annual subscription fee is £56 and covers the period 1 October 2024 to 30 September 2025. A payment window will be open from September 2024 until 31 March 2025. The charge is £56 regardless of when you sign up.

Once you've signed up and paid, we'll empty your garden waste on your scheduled collection day. However, if this is after the 1 October 2024 the later you leave it to subscribe the higher the chance that your collection day will change.

If you don't subscribe, we won't empty your garden bin after 1 October 2024."

The website also states.

“You could have up to three bins but would pay a separate subscription fee for each bin, ie a maximum of £168.”

If you do not subscribe you will have to either compost your waste or take it to a recycle centre, the nearest of which is Bridgnorth. If you put garden waste in the general waste bin then this will not be emptied.

Some will say Halesfield is nearer, which is of course correct, however this is in Telford and Wrekin and although we all use it, if a ticket system is introduced, using post codes, residents would find using Halesfield would not be allowed.
